#### ***CAMDEN COUNTY SHERIFF'S MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP***

The Camden County Sheriff's Memorial Endowment Fund was established to memorialize four officers who fell in the line of duty while in service with the Camden County Sheriff's Office: John Hazelton, Dennis Ray Herring, Walter Nathan Coleman and Sgt. Dan Jenkins. The scholarship provides support for needy, at risk applicants who are seeking a degree in any field of study, preferably related to law enforcement or criminal justice.

Recipients shall be selected by the Scholarship Committee of Armstrong Atlantic State University with recommendation from the specific departmental scholarship committee. The \$750 scholarship will be awarded each fall and spring semester to a student who best meets the following criteria:

1. The student may be in any field of study but preference will be given to those fields related to law enforcement or criminal justice;
2. The student must agree to work in a law enforcement or criminal justice post for a period of time equal to the length of the award;
3. The student is financially needy, and
4. The student must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.50.
