John T. Rowden, Sr. Memorial Scholarship

The JOHN T. ROWDEN, SR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is sponsored by the Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Association of Retirees (ATFAR). John Rowden retired as a special agent with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and was a special deputy sheriff with the Chatham County Sheriff's Department. The scholarship amount is \$500 for each Spring and Fall semester and will be awarded to a criminal justice major who is a non-traditional student, employed by a criminal justice agency, preferably in law enforcement. Juniors, seniors, and graduates are encouraged to apply.

Recipients shall be selected by the scholarship committee in the Department of Criminal Justice, Social and Political Science. The \$500 scholarship will be awarded each fall and spring semester to a student who best meets the following criteria:

1. Is a non-traditional criminal justice major already employed by a criminal justice agency;
2. Is financially needy;
3. Has attained at least junior standing or is a graduate student; and
4. Is currently enrolled at AASU.
